

Gospel Reflections 4th Sunday January 28th 2024

Jesus speaks to the devil...

He speaks with authority and supreme self-confidence. Could you do that if you met an evil spirit? Would you feel lost and afraid about how to respond?

I remember the story of a farmer standing by the side of a country road. A sports car from the city roars up and skids to a stop next to him. The impatient driver yells, "Hey farmer! I'm lost here. Do you know how to get to the freeway?" The farmer calmly thinks and replies, "Nope." The driver responds, "Well, you have got to be the dumbest farmer I ever met! I am lost here and you cannot help! Don't you know anything at all!?" The farmer calmly thinks and says, "Well ...I know I'm not lost!"

Jesus was never lost or afraid in facing any evil. He knew precisely who He was and how to respond. There is no parable, story, or long teaching here. Jesus simply says, *Get out!* The evil spirit understood that perfectly ... and left!
