What to Expect This Year

Edge Nights

Edge Nights happen **about twice a month** in the Hall and are designed to be fun, engaging, and meaningful. There are three main types of Edge Nights:

- *Catechetical Nights* – These nights break open key parts of our Catholic faith. We'll dive into topics like prayer, sacraments, and the life of Jesus, helping youth grow in their relationship with God.
- *Issue Nights* – These nights address real-world issues that youth face, like peer pressure, gossip, friendships, and growing up in today's world. Youth will see how their Catholic faith can guide them through these challenges.
- *Social Nights* – These nights are all about building friendships and community. We'll hang out, play games, and have fun, all while growing closer as a community of followers of Christ.

- **Fall Kickoff Day**
- **First Supper** (attend with at least one parent)
- **Edge Family Nights** (attend with at least one parent)
- **XLT** (three times per year)
- **Off-Site Outing**
- **Evening Retreat**

- **First Supper** (with your child)
- **Two (2) Family Edge Nights**
- **Two (2) Parent Faith Nights**
